Monday, 11th September



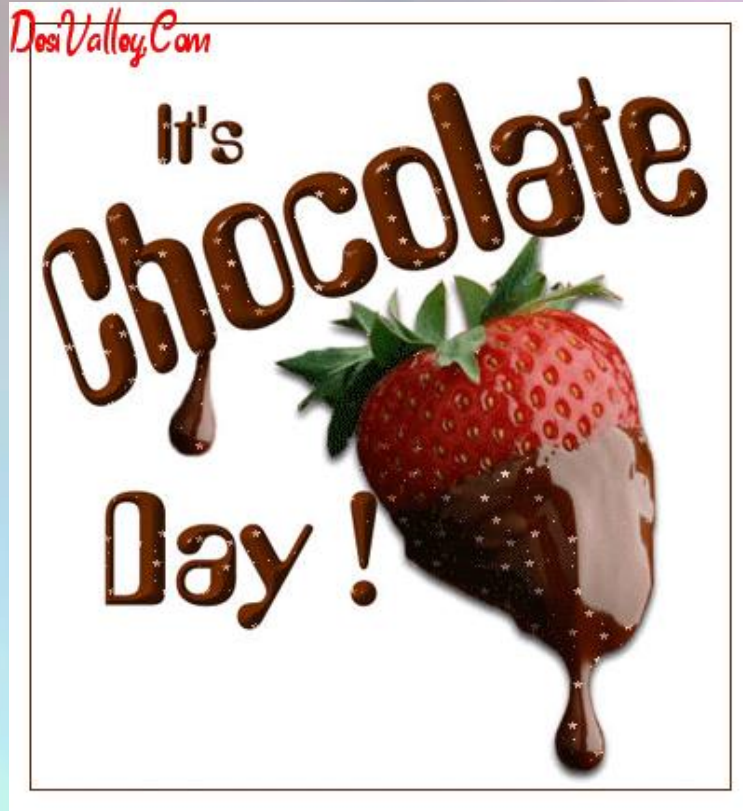
- It is 22 years ago today when passenger planes were crashed into the Twin Towers in New York city.

Colouring:

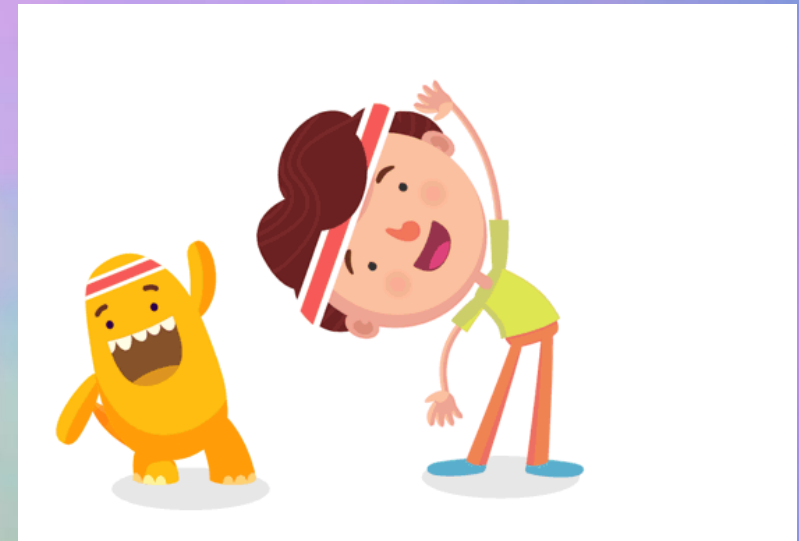
- **Improves Brain Function** – Colouring activates different parts of the brain, including logic and creativity.

- **Helps you sleep** - Colouring before going to sleep keeps the eyes and brain away from the blue light of electronic devices.



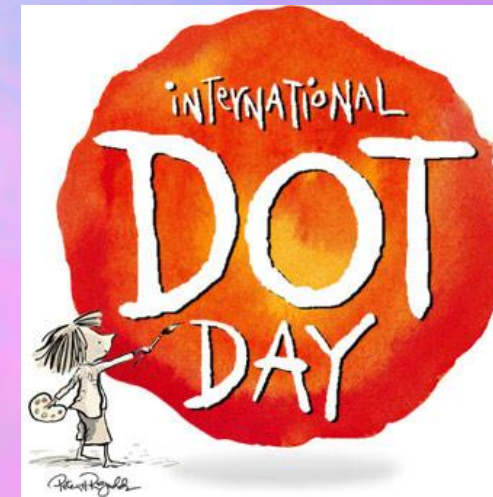
Thursday, 14th September
