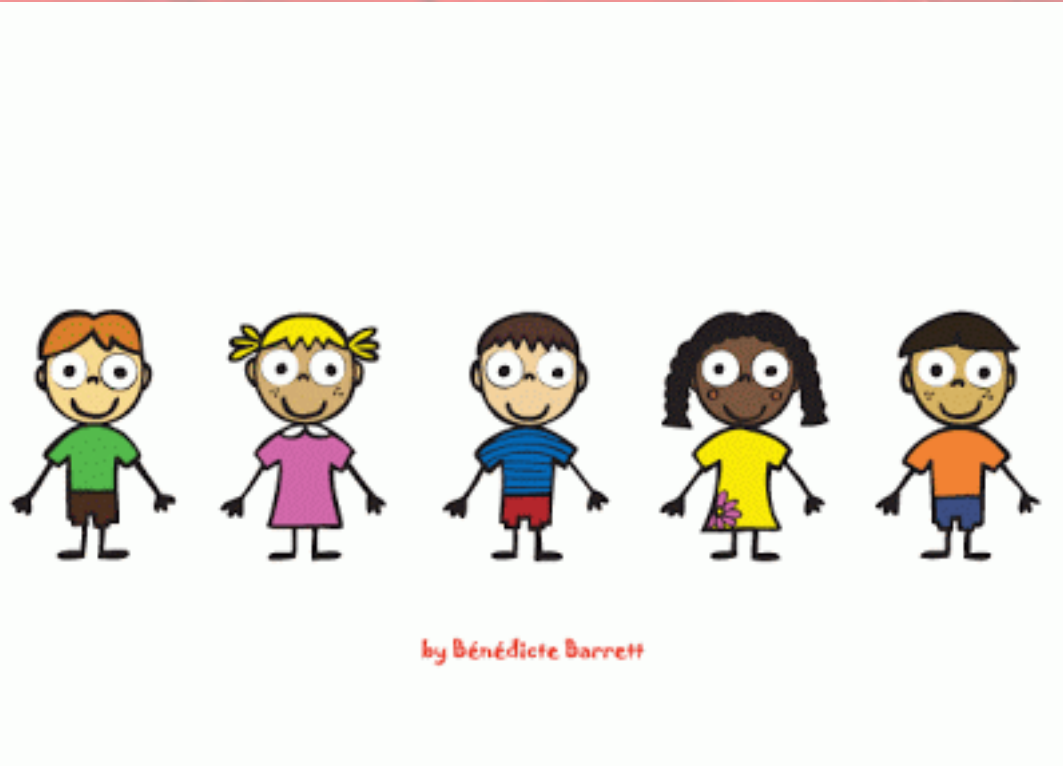

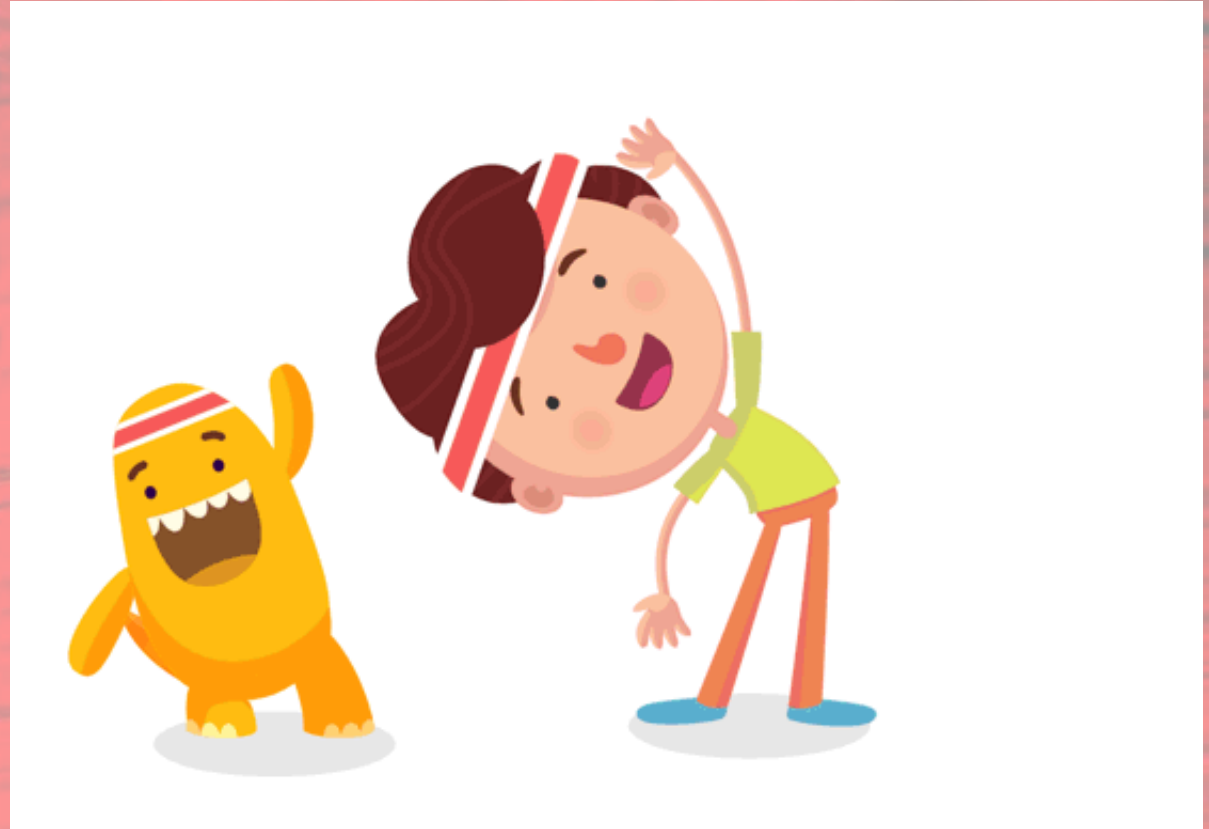
Monday, 20th November is World Children's Day

- **Have fun!**



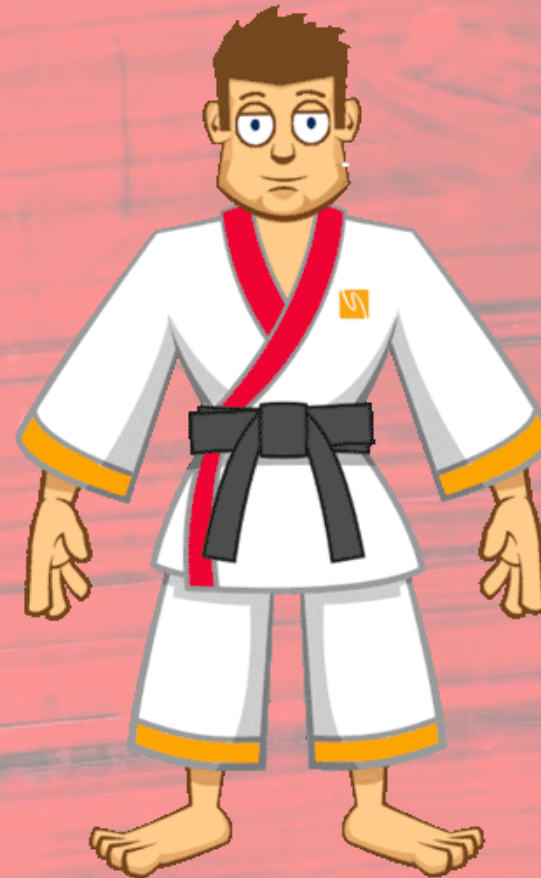

- (How many have been women?)



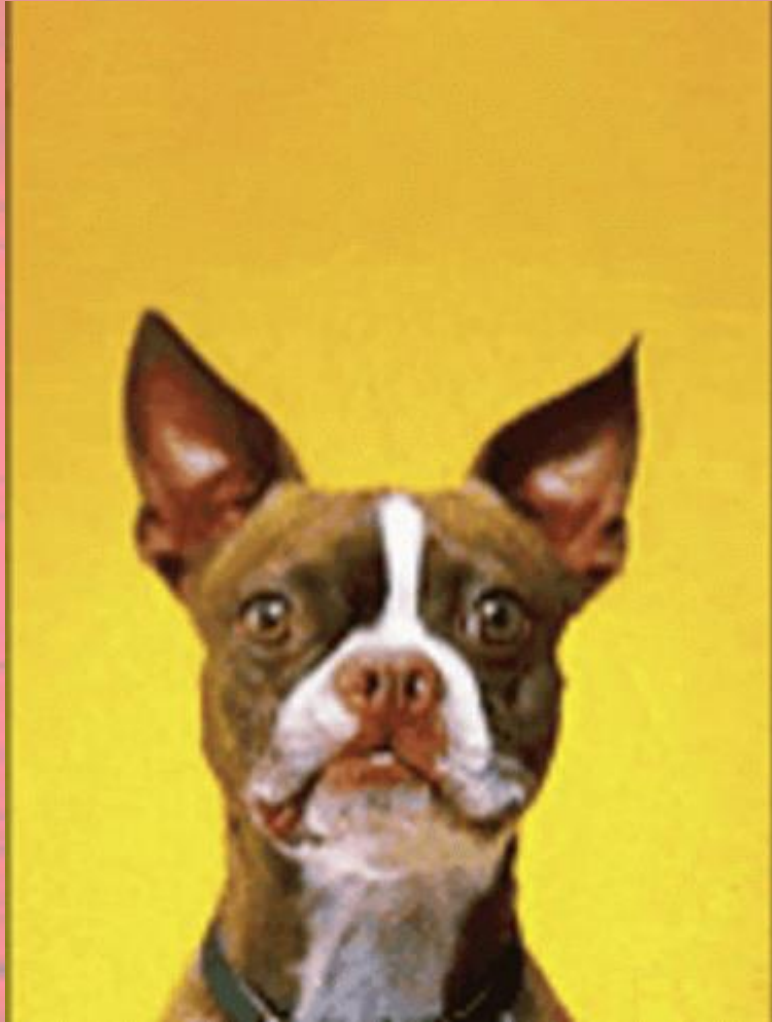
